DIRECTORS REPORT (TONY COUROUNIS AND SOPHIA SANTERRE

Mr. Courounis spoke with the middle school music directors and received permission to send an informational Band Uniform Campaign letter to parents of the 6^{th} , 7^{th} and 8^{th} grade band members.

The *Annual Nashua Plays Festival* takes place at Nashua North on Tuesday, April 12th. Select Band students participate at the festival during the school day. Students typically bussed to school are required to be both, be dropped off directly at North in the morning and picked up at North after school; students who typically drive themselves to and from school are permitted to drive to North and park for the day. Students should arrive at back at Nashua North for 5:45 pm, concert at 7:00pm; tickets are \$5.00 and are available until Monday through Mr. Courounis or purchased at the door on April 12.

The *South Jazz Night* takes place in the Nashua South Cafeteria on Wednesday, April13th at 7pm. Admission is free. The evening features the Fairgrounds Middle School Jazz Band, The Nashua South Jazz Band, The Nashua South Jazz Choir, and the Nashua South Honor's Jazz Band.

South's Jazz and Honor's Jazz Bands will participle at the *Souhegan Jazz Night*; which takes place at Souhegan High School Thursday, April 21st. Concert 6:00pm, tickets \$10/ adult and \$8/ students and are available at the door. Students leave from South at 3:30 and stop for dinner.
