Reporting for Sophia Santerre: 1. Many thanks to those who chaperoned the trip which was very successful: the choirs received 3 "superior" ratings: Jazz Choir took first place, Concert Choir took 2nd out of 3 (missed first place by 1.5 points) and Chorale came in 3 out of 5 – missed first place by less than one point (less than one point separated the 3 top choirs in this category!). 2. We are looking into some monetary reimbursement from the bus company for the inconveniences caused – the amount will be divided amongst the students once received. 3. We are looking for parents to sell tickets at the concert and assist with programs and seating.

Reporting for Tony Courounis: 1. I would also like to thank the parents who chaperoned the trip. I am very proud of all of the accomplishments from our music groups who participated in Williamsburg! The Bands who participated received 1 "superior rating" and 2 "excellent ratings". The Honors Jazz Band took first place in their division (no competition in their division, but scored a "superior rating") and they also earned "the Highest Score Award" for any jazz band in all divisions. The Concert Band took first place with an "excellent rating" (one other band in their division) and the Jazz Band took first place with an "excellent rating" (one other band in their division). Michael Hirsch was awarded the "Top Soloist Award" for all Jazz Bands and the Honors Band rhythm section was awarded the "Top Section Award" for all of the Jazz Bands.

A vote was taken and there were 20 votes to do this and none opposed. Part of this can be a 5 year non-binding agreement to lock in today's price.

In working on the DVD for awards night, so far only 13 out 40 seniors have turned in their photos (baby & high school). They are due back by this Friday.

Unfinished Business: Gift for Sophia's retirement has been purchased. It is a digital picture frame pre-loaded with pictures from her years at South.
